REVISION TO NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS 04-72

EMERGENCY STONE BANK PROTECTION

OHIO RIVER, MILE 155.1

Reference Notice to Navigation Interests 04-72 dated 1 November 2004. Due to unanticipated high water, the completion date has been changed to 30 July 2005. All other pertinent information remains the same.

For your convenience, the following is from Notice to Navigation Interests 04-72:

Notice is given that on or about 8 November 2004, Madison Coal and Supply Company, contractor for the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Huntington District, will begin emergency stone bank protection work along the left descending bank of the Ohio River, mile 155.1 in the Middle Island backchannel. During this work, material will be dredged from the work site and disposed in an approved upland disposal area at O- KAN harbor, along the right descending bank of the Ohio River, mile 267.0.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V LADY LOIS, one barge mounted crane, and two material barges. The M/V LADY LOIS will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. Work will be performed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on or about 27 February 2005.

During non-working hours, the floating plant will be moored at the work site and lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to use extreme caution in the area.
