Stephen G. Durrett was appointed to the Senior Executive Service in January 2015. He serves as the Programs Director of the Great Lakes and Ohio River Division (LRD), U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. As the Programs Director, Mr. Durrett provides leadership and supervision for the LRD Programs Directorate's execution, planning, and project management activities.

The division operates as a regional business center with seven engineer districts covering 335,000 miles in seventeen states and consists of about 4,200 team members. LRD is responsible for water resource solutions throughout the Great Lakes and Ohio River watersheds. The division's civil works missions include navigation, flood risk management, hydropower, environmental restoration, regulatory permitting, emergency response, water supply management, and recreation. LRD also executes a military construction program in Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana, Illinois and Michigan with the design and construction of barracks, hospitals, airfields and family housing on military installations.

Mr. Durrett previously served as Deputy District Engineer and the Chief of Programming and Project Management Division at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' Louisville District. Also, during his time at the Louisville District he served in several different positions that include Chief of the Engineering Division, Chief of the Engineering Branch, Chief of the Design Branch, Chief of the Geotechnical & Dam Safety Section and Chief of the Environmental Engineering Branch. His special assignments include the Levee Safety Program Manager at Headquarters U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and Chief of the Planning Branch for the Louisville District. Mr. Durrett also served on the Forward Engineering Support Team while deployed to Hillah, Iraq.

Mr. Durrett holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Kentucky, a Master of Science Degree in Geotechnical Engineering from the University of Cincinnati. He is certified as a Level III Facilities Engineers and is a licensed Professional Engineer in the state of Kentucky. He is also a member of the American Society of Military Engineers.

He has received numerous awards and decoration during his Federal service including the Superior Civilian Service Award, Engineering Excellence Award, and the Army Engineer Association Bronze de Fleury Medal.
